Application to register interest

The 13th International Symposium on Fireworks being held in Malta shall focus on bringing together individuals of diverse pyrotechnic background to provide a fertile atmosphere in which to see the newest technology, to trade experience and ideas on ways to enhance the industry and to move the science forward. The emphasis of the Symposium is on the presentation of papers and the discussion of topics dealing with the safety, scientific, engineering, artistic, and regulatory aspects of fireworks and other pyrotechnics associated with entertainment and celebration on a global basis.

The Malta International Fireworks Festival is held annually on the last two days of April in the unique setting of the Grand Harbour in Valletta. A number of Maltese and international manufacturers and companies participate in pyromusical and traditional displays displaying a wide range of different and unique pyrotechnic effects.

1. Scope

To select Maltese and International pyrotechnic manufacturers / companies to present fireworks displays synchronised to music during the International Symposium on Fireworks and the Malta International Fireworks Festival being held in Malta between the 23rd to 27th April 2012 and on the 29th and 30th April 2012 respectively.

- Duration of the show (at least 15 minutes)
- Certification issued by the appropriate National Body stating that the pyrotechnic manufacturer / company is authorised and in possession of a licence in the country of origin.
- The Manufacturer / Company shall comply with all relevant European Union laws including but not limited to 'The Control of Fireworks and other Explosives Regulations'.
- The Manufacturer / Company shall not import any other pyrotechnical material into Malta without the approval of the Malta Host Committee. For avoidance of all doubt and dispute, the Manufacturer / Company shall utilise the Material solely for the purpose of the Show.

3. Closing dates

Applications are to be received by the 31st December 2011.
